## **Legitimacy**

- an equal and fair process (transparent, etc.)
- empowered MPPs
- majority of population should be satisfied with the result
- adequately voice the values and needs of the majority, regardless of specific geographic area
- people should be satisfied

## **Fairness of Representation**

- my vote should count
- satisfaction that your voice was heard
- local concerns should be heard
- all votes should be equal
- timeliness of votes
- diversity of representation
- accurate reflection of the will of the people
- proportionality
- regional fairness of representation

## **Voter Choice**

- a meaningful and real choice
- informed choices
- tolerance for independents and alternative choices

## **Effective Parties**

- parties should be effective
- fair treatment of political parties

## **Stable and Effective Government**

- the results should produce a stable system that works well
- form a government
- good government

## **Effective Parliament**

- individuals should be effective in parliament

## **Stronger Voter Participation**

- encourage participation without coercion
- an accessible process
- high voter turnout
- promote meaningful participation

## **Accountability**

- Accountability
- Responsible/accountable MPPs
- individual representative should be available

- understandable to the public (results/process)
- simple, practical
- a logical process
